**British Science Week Poster Competition 2026**

As part of British Science Week (6th – 15th March), we would like to invite the children to enter the annual poster competition! This year the British Science Week poster competition is linked to a real scientific research question. The UK government are thinking about how to build a positive future for children. So, they are asking: **What is a good childhood?**

Here are some questions to get your child thinking about what to put on the poster:

What things make your life good now?

What did a good childhood look like in the past? *Ask some grown-ups to tell you about what made their life good when they were children.*

Imagine if you have your own children in the future. What would a positive childhood look like for them?

What will they be playing / doing / eating / learning / thinking?

What do children in other countries around the world enjoy?

How is this the same or different to what makes your life positive?

The poster must be: A4 or A3 size. Pupils can use pop up pictures, pull out tabs or use materials such as paint, drawing pencils, crayons and paper. Please bring all completed posters into school by **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> of March 2026**. Posters will be judged during Science Week, the top 5 will receive prizes and their posters will be entered into the national British Science Week competition.
