**Educational Visit to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park, Wakefield.**

On **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July**, our Year 2 children will be going on a trip to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park. This trip will link into our Art learning in the last term, and will give children the experience of being inspired by large sculptures. We will be exploring the sculptures during an education session called 'Outdoor Sculpture Building,' which is led by an artist educator from the park.

We will be leaving school at **8:30am** so your child will need to arrive at school no later than **8:10am**. We are aiming to get back to school for **4:15pm**, but we will keep you informed if it will be any later.

As the trip is predominantly outdoors, children must wear **school uniform** on the day suitable for the weather, as well as suitable footwear as there will be a lot of walking! They may also need to bring sun cream and sunhats.

Please note that your child is entitled to Universal Free School Meals and a packed lunch can be supplied for them for the day; please indicate on the online consent form whether you require a lunch from school, or whether you will be providing your child with one from home.

We regularly enrich the curriculum by taking our pupils out on visits, and subsidise as much of the cost as we can, however, in order for the trip to go ahead, we do require a voluntary contribution of **£15** per child, which can be paid via the School Gateway app. We would be grateful if your contribution could be sent and the online consent form completed, using the following link: <https://forms.cloud.microsoft/e/q7EgvPawB4> by **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.
