As part of the 'National Safety Awareness Campaign', year 5 have been invited to attend the Safety Awareness Event taking place on **Wednesday 17th June 2026 at the Vicar Water Country Park, Clipstone.**

As part of this event there will be a host of organisations such as Newark Community First Aid, Nottinghamshire Police, British Transport Police, Newark & Sherwood District Council Park Rangers and Nottinghamshire Fire & Rescue, all holding educational sessions for our pupils to participate in, learning invaluable skills.

The trip will be within normal school hours, so children will need to come to school at the normal time of **8:45am**. We are aiming to be back at school for **14.30pm**, so normal collection time of 3.20pm.

Children must wear school uniform on the day, trainers are permitted due to uneven ground and will need a **packed lunch, a non-fizzy drink and a bag** to carry everything with them for the visit.
