Dear Parents/Carers,

Lake View Kitchen Refurbishment – August to October 2026

We are excited to inform you that the Lake View Kitchen is set to undergo a significant refurbishment, bringing the kitchen up to modern kitchen standards and ensuring the highest quality meals can be delivered daily to our children.

The refurbishment is being financed using capital funding from our trust, the *East Midlands Education Trust (EMET)*, and will bring us into line with recent refurbishments at both Blidworth Oaks and Heathlands.

The work will start during the summer holidays in order to utilise the holiday period and ensure the least disruption to the school. However, because of the size of the project, work will continue until the October half term so will be ongoing whilst the school is in operation during September and October.

Please rest assured that the project itself will be fully separated and isolated from the rest of school to ensure safety for all. It will not affect general school spaces such as classrooms, corridors or halls. It may affect the access and egress from the upper school playground at drop off and pick up times, but this will be minor and we will manage this closer to the time.

Of course, this project will affect the provision of school dinners. During this period, we intend to utilise our partnership of schools to continue to provide meals, cooked at either Blidworth Oaks or Heathlands, and transported to Lake View ready for the daily dinner service. All three of our schools follow the same menu so this will not affect pupil meal choices. All of our kitchens are fully set up to cater with any allergies or other dietary requirements just as you receive now via the Lake View Kitchen. Therefore, because of these measures, we anticipate little disruption to pupils' daily school dinner routine and provision.

I will contact you again before we return to school on Thursday 3rd September in order to confirm the dinner arrangements and any other measures we may have to put in place to enable school to continue to operate safely as the work takes place.
