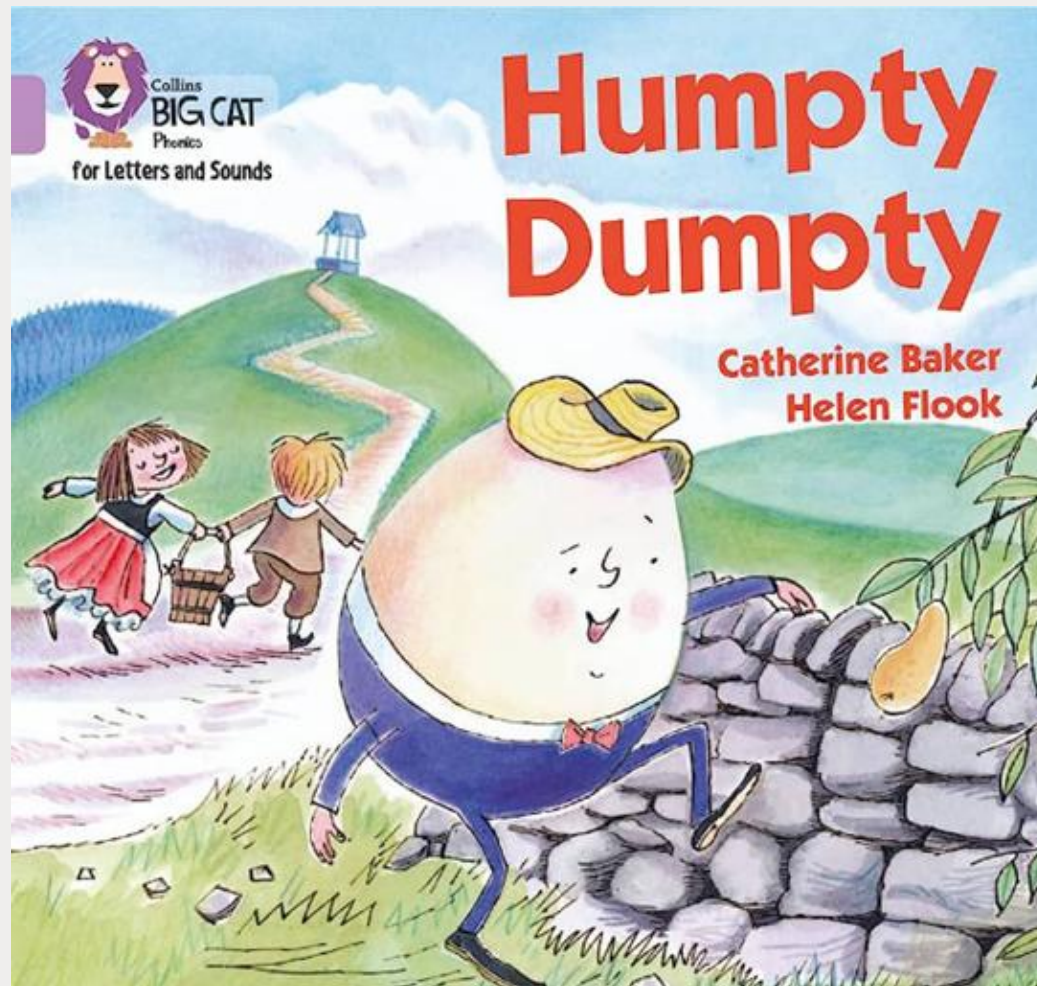
Building Confident Readers

Reading is one of the most important skills your child will learn, and we work together to make it enjoyable.

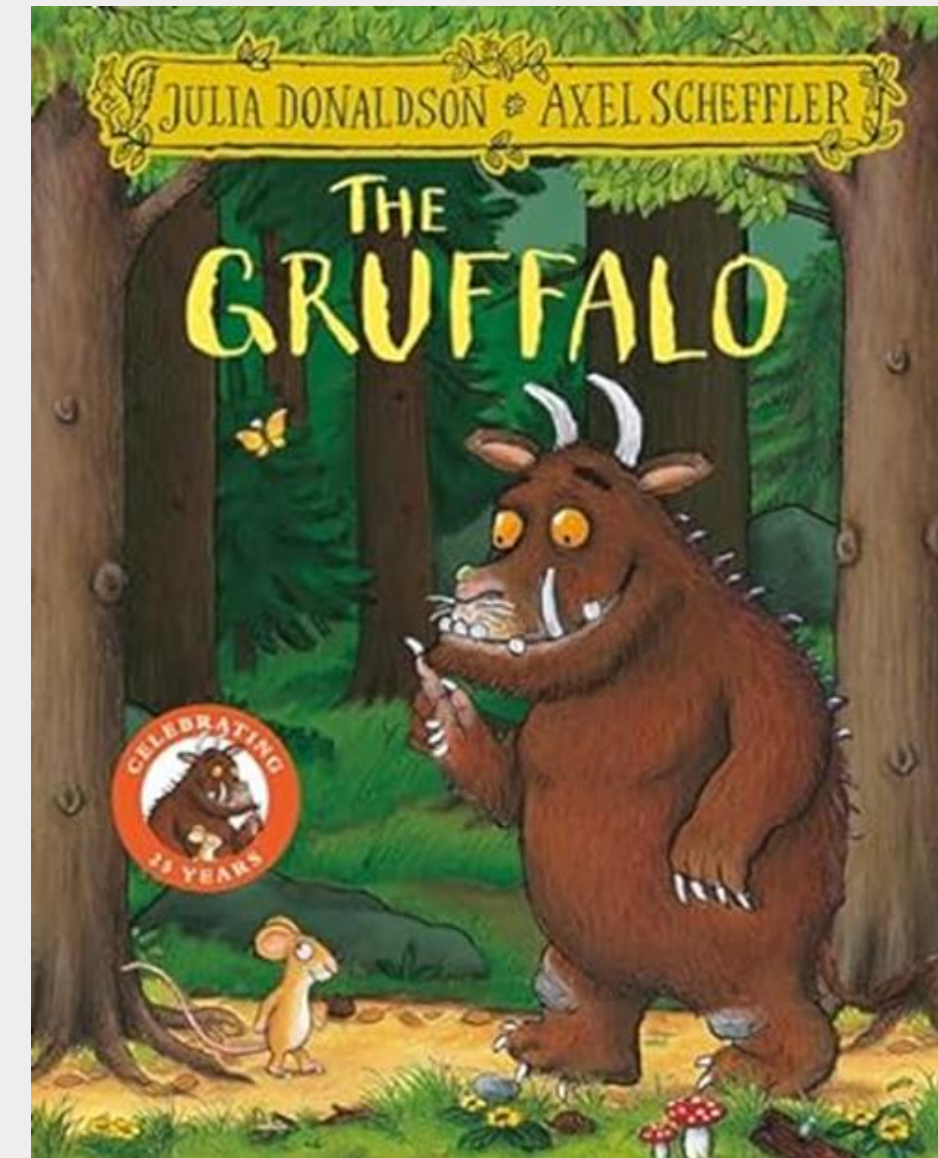
Our reading journey starts from day one with:

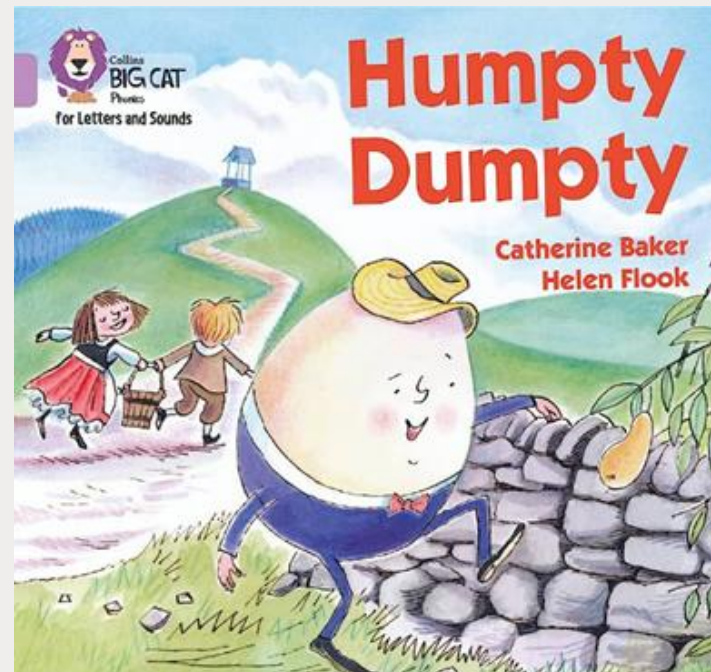

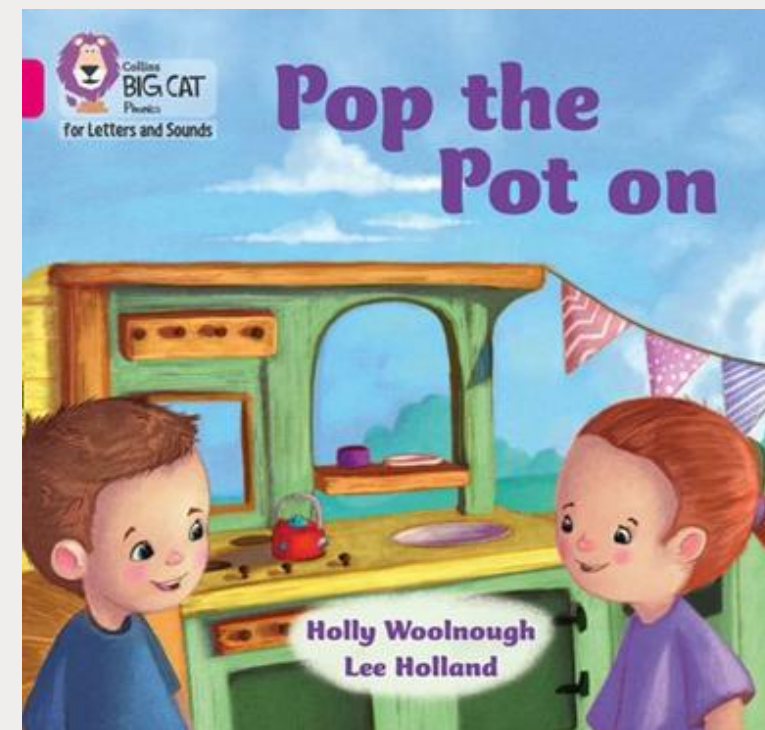
