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The Lake View High 5

The Lake View High 5 is a school reward for children who show an outstanding commitment to their education. It brings together several of our school's positive reward systems such as the collection of Value Points and the Reading Challenge.

What is it?

The Lake View High 5 takes place every term - three times a year (Autumn, Spring and Summer). To achieve the Lake View high 5 you need to accomplish the following five actions each term:

1. Homework

- Complete all homework set each week.



Uniform

- Wear correct school uniform every day, including black shoes.
- Wear correct school PE kit.



Reading

- Complete our Reading Challenge by reading 50 times or more at home recorded in home reading diary.



Value Points

- Earn 50 or more Value Points, without any 'Red' behaviours and a maximum of five 'Orange' behaviours.



Attendance

- Children must be absent for no more two days absence per term



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What should you do?

- Encourage and support your child to complete the Lake View High 5.
- If your child doesn't complete the Lake View High 5 one term, please remind them that each term is another opportunity.
- The cut-off date for each Lake View High 5 is as follows: 8th December 2023, 15th March 2024 and 12th July 2024. Please be aware that the next term's High 5 starts immediately after each cut-off date.

Children who achieve the Lake View High 5 will be invited to take part in a reward event at the end of term. This will be voted on by the children!
